## Hawks Nest Trail

1.8 miles long: hike & bike  
Hawks Nest Branch Line: 1890 - 1972  
Its 4.17% Grade, 4.5 miles long, was one of  
the steepest branch lines on the C&O. A  
narrow gage rail line began construction in  
1870 and was completed just after the  
main line was finished - it was upgraded to  
a standard gauge in 1889.

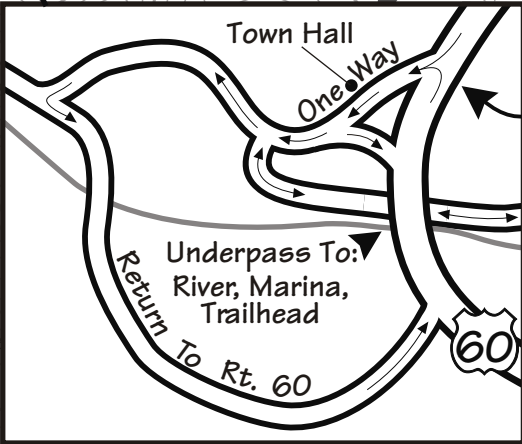
